

Steps to the application process

- Read the guidelines and policies thoroughly.
- Complete the online application.
- Add grants@paws4acure.org into your email address book.
- You will need to provide the treating veterinarian with the Veterinary Packet and Veterinary W9 or direct them to the Veterinary Professionals page.
- You will email or fax your required documents to Paws 4 A Cure.
- You will receive an email acknowledgement within 24 hours of receipt of your required documentation.
- We strongly urge you to apply to several different financial assistance programs along with applying to Paws 4 A Cure, links to which can be found on our Helpful Resources page. Please do not rely on a Paws 4 A Cure grant only.
- Once all of the required documentation are received from you and the treating veterinarian, Paws 4 A Cure will start the application review.

If your required documentation is not received within 2 days of your online application, the application will move from pending to closed status. You will have to reapply for assistance.

If your application for assistance is approved:

- You will receive an approval email with an acceptance letter that you are to provide to the treating veterinary practice.
- You will complete the requirements so that Paws 4 A Cure can create your dog/cat's fundraising page. Once you receive the email that your fundraising page is completed, you must share your fundraising page with your friends, family and local news media to help generate donations.
- Your dog/cat will receive the veterinary treatment.
- The veterinary practice will email or fax the detailed invoice to Paws 4 A Cure.
- Paws 4 A Cure will send a check via the U.S. mail to the veterinary practice within 30 days following receipt of an itemized invoice emailed or faxed by the veterinary practice.
